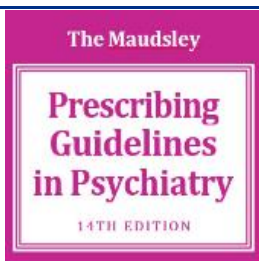

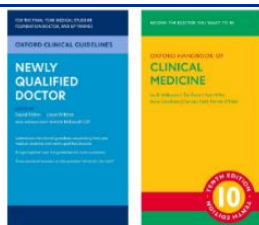

While these key websites don't have a specific app, you can add a shortcut to them on the homescreen of your phone to make it easier to find them:

### iPhone or iPad

- Use Safari to find the website you want
- Tap the **Share** button at the bottom of the page (a square with an arrow pointing out the top)
- Tap **Add to Home Screen**
- Give the shortcut a name

### Android

- Use Chrome to find the website you want
- Tap the menu icon (3 dots in upper right hand corner) and tap **Add** to home screen
- Give the shortcut a name
